- ***DO NOT EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING AFTER MIGNIGHT. Your surgery will be cancelled if you do not follow this instruction.***
- **Your arrival time to the surgery center will be provided the day before your scheduled surgery.**
- Patient's are required to have a driver (18 years or older). You may not drive for the first 24 hours after surgery. You may not drive yourself home or leave alone. A family member/friend must remain onsite during surgery.
- All patients should expect a phone call from a Carolina Specialty Eye Surgery Assessment Nurse one week prior to their scheduled surgery. You will need to be able to provide medical history and confirm all medications you are currently taking including over the counter medications.
- You may take your regular medications with a small amount of water UNLESS you are given other instructions by the assessment nurse,
- All patients should please wear clean and comfortable clothes and shoes. Patients should also wear a button-down shirt.
- **NO** makeup or nail polish, perfume, cologne on the day of surgery. **NO** jewelry the day of surgery. Please do not bring valuables into the surgery center.
